- Secure loads using chains, binders, and other equipment
- Drive defensively and anticipate hazards on the road
- Maintain accurate logs and records as required by state and federal regulations
- Communicate effectively with dispatchers, other drivers, and mill personnel
- Adhere to all safety regulations and procedures
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Valid commercial driver's license (CDL) with appropriate endorsements
- MUST Complete have an up-to-date MVR at the time of interview
- 2+ years of experience driving large trucks, preferably in the logging industry
- Strong mechanical aptitude and the ability to diagnose and repair minor issues on the road
- **Excellent driving record with no major violations or accidents**
- Willingness to work long hours and in adverse weather conditions
- Ability to read and interpret maps and driving directions

Physical Requirements

- Able to lift and carry heavy objects up to 50 pounds
- Able to climb in and out of cab and trailer multiple times per day
- Able to sit for extended periods of time while driving
- Able to work in all weather conditions, including extreme heat and cold
